

A Better Way To Search Legal Ads

In a tight market, finding work can be a challenge and the Alabama Press Association has a website that may simplify the search through legal advertisements for public works jobs out for bid.

The website, www.AlabamaLegals.com, is a statewide collection of legal notices from most of Alabama's newspapers. The site is updated with new legal notices daily. Notices can be searched manually by county, newspaper, key word or start date at no cost.

Now the Press Association has added a subscription email service to the site. For \$35 a month, a subscriber can receive by email up to 10 different search profiles daily. New searches will be delivered by email to subscribers by 8 a.m.

"Users set up their own search profiles allowing as many as 10 different counties, and can indicate key words to locate the particular notices they want to find," said Leigh Tortorici, senior marketing representative. "Searches may be modified at any time for the duration of the subscription at no additional charge."

"Typical users are looking for things like foreclosures for certain counties or construction bids in particular areas," Tortorici said. "The benefit for subscribers is that you won't miss anything – results are sent to you every day. And the comprehensive email is more convenient than pulling up notices one by one from the main site."
